Role of alternative medicine in managing uterine fibroid

Learning Objectives

- Managing asymptomatic uterine fibroids with the help of homeopathic medicine, non-surgically
- Management of uterine fibroids in cases with dysfunctional uterine bleeding or other symptoms with the help of homeopathic medicines and other auxiliary measures.



- 37 year old female, presented with a complaint of heartburn and regurgitation.
- Menstrual history: 3-4 / 28-32 days, No history of leucorrhoea or any other infection
- Obstetric history: G5P2A3L2; 2FTND
 She was given a medicine called AURUM MUR NAT 6C
- 4pills*BD for 3 months. Along with some antacids homeopathic bio-combination
- After (3) months, No fibroids were seen on gynaecological ultrasound and reconfirmed with other USG.



Case 2:

- A 24 year female, nullipara, presented With irregular menstrual bleeding with leucorrhoea & severe abdominal discomfort.
 - -She was on treatment for primary, infertility & was on HRT (Hormone replacement therapy) for the same. Hence, primarily it was Misdiagnosed as this metrorrhagia is just because of HRT(Hormone replacement therapy) and treated symptomatically.
- -She was managed with anti- Hemorrhagic medicine and then given AURUM MUR NAT 6C 4pills BD for 5 months. -Her menstrual cycle was regularized; 3-4/30-35 days without any significant abdominal discomfort.

Discussion:

Here I have used AURUM MUR NAT 6C in maximum of the cases. Hence, presenting it here with Some other symptomatic management & auxiliary management

Like — weight loss, a yoga posture called "SHWAN KRIYA" is useful in such cases to minimize the symptoms.

Conclusion:

By using Homoeopathic medicine and other auxiliary measures, in the majority of cases, Uterine fibroid can be managed non surgically.
